## **Directions to Fox Cemetery**

**From Lovell Village: Travel approximately 2 1/4 miles. After Lake Kezar Golf Course, take West Lovell road on left. Follow West Lovell Road about 2.7 miles and veer left onto Foxboro Road. Continue on Foxboro Road, going by New Road on left. Continue by Horseshoe Pond Road on the right and onto a dirt road (Mine Road). Road goes by Lord Cemetery on left and curves to left past the parking area for Lord Hill hiking trail. Look for the cemetery on the right about 1/8 of a mile further. The cemetery is sign posted.**

**The cemetery is bordered by rock walls on all sides. The entrance is ungated with two granite pillars on each side. There are many missing stones and it is hard to know what may be the base of a stone.**
