## **Directions to Lord Cemetery**

From Lovell Village: Travel approximately 2 1/4 miles north on Route 5. After Lake Kezar Golf Course, take West Lovell road on left. Follow West Lovell Road about 2.7 miles and veer left onto Foxboro Road. Continue on Foxboro Road going by New Road on left (approximately 4.3 miles). Continue past Horseshoe Pond Road on the right and onto a dirt road (Mine Road). Soon after you start onto dirt road, look for cemetery on left. It is sign posted.

The cemetery is in the woods and up a slight embankment. There are three readable stones, with many small stones (approximately 26) that may or may not be old grave markers.
