Directions to the Village Cemetery

The Village Cemetery is located next to the woods to the west of Route 5 and Lovell flat (the area between New Suncook School and the Village Cemetery. The public section measures 132' x 120' and is surrounded by a rail fence made of 2x4 boards.

Coming from the south: it is just south of Lovell Village on the left just after the New Suncook School which is on the right. The entrance is next to a brown house and the drive into the cemetery looks like it may be to enter this home.

Coming from the North on Route 5: as you come into Lovell Village area, look for Charlotte Hobbs Library on the left and the Post Office on the right. Route 5 bears to the right. Look for the sign for the Village Cemetery on the right. A dirt road cuts into the cemetery.

From Sweden (Rte. 93/Sweden Road): follow Rte. 93 (Sweden Road) into Lovell and when the road forks, fork left onto Rte 5 South towards Fryeburg. Look for Village Cemetery sign on the right.

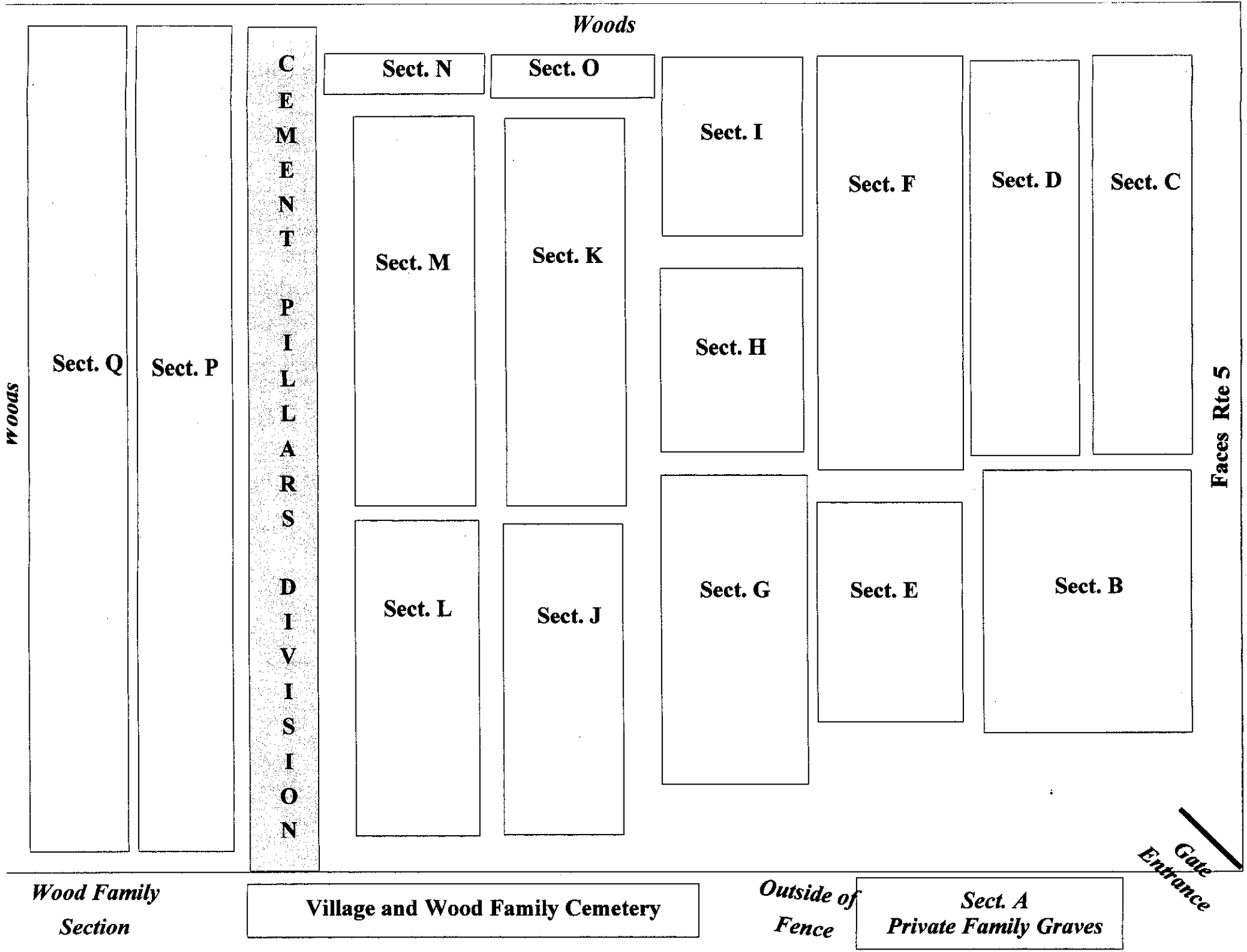

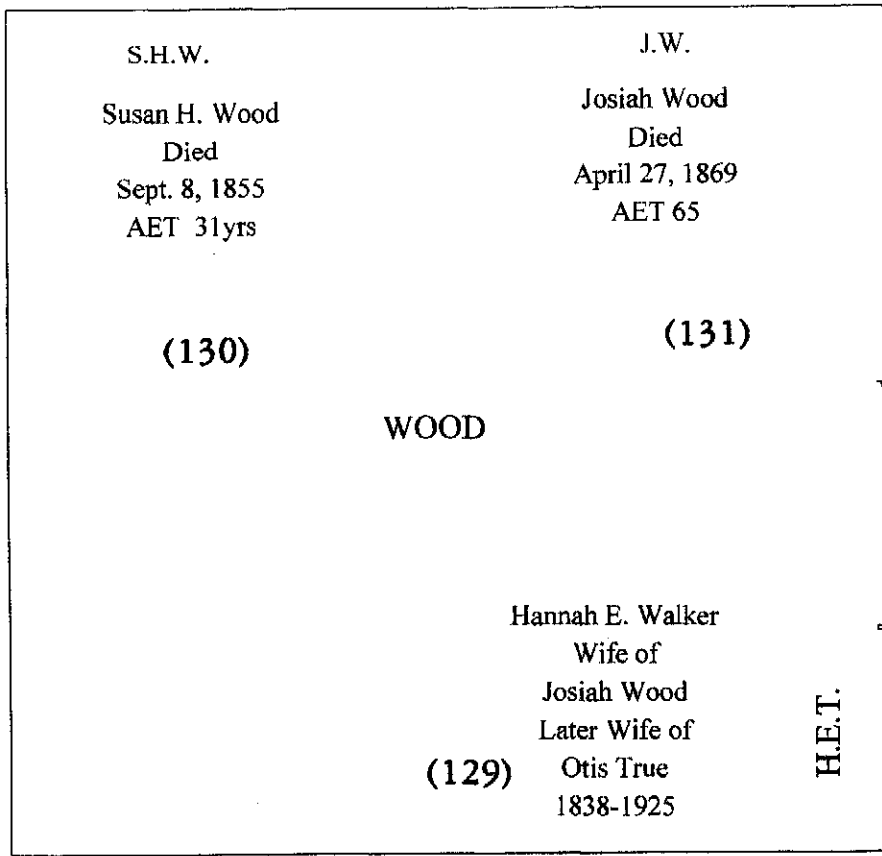
